
DDA regulations

Description

It is important to understand that all manifestation and graphics to glass screens and doors must comply within a minimum requirement by law. This is known as the Building Regulations 2000.

The Building Regulations 2000, Part M states; **2.24** Glass entrance doors and glazed screens will satisfy Requirement M1 or M2 if:

a. They are clearly defined with manifestation on the glass at two levels, 850 to 1000mm and 1400 to 1600mm above the floor, contrasting visually with the background seen through the glass (both from inside and outside) in all lighting conditions;

b. Manifestation takes the form of a logo or sign at least 150mm high (repeating if on glazed screen), or a decorative feature such as broken lines or continuous bands, at least 50mm high
